

HAPPY VALLEY BOWLING CLUB

BY-LAW - GREENS & GROUNDS MANAGEMENT

1. The Board of Management shall have the power to appoint a Grounds Management Committee and a Groundsman or Groundsmen as required to manage and maintain the greens and all of the grounds and surrounds of the club, with the following responsibilities –
 - a. Maintain the playing surfaces and the surrounds in the best possible condition.
 - b. Purchase chemicals and other materials necessary for this, and for the upkeep and maintenance of machinery and other club equipment. All purchases must meet guidelines in the club's Authority to Purchase By Law.
 - c. Recommend equipment replacement and/or the purchase of new equipment as necessary.
2. Members of the committee and any groundsmen shall not necessarily be members of the Board of Management but are responsible to the Board through a designated member. A brief monthly report is required to keep the Board informed.
3. The Groundsman or Groundsmen shall have full control and supervision of the playing area and power to prevent play at any time when it is considered the playing area may be damaged, subject to advising the Club President or designate, and where applicable, MBA and/or Bowls SA. Notice to this effect posted by the Groundsman or Groundsmen shall be sufficient advice to all players.
4. In all other respects the supervision and control of the playing area and grounds shall be in the hands of the Board of Management, who's ruling thereon shall be final.
