Please see Mary Baum if you wish to offload uniforms.


All other bowls equipment or attire can no longer be displayed in the Clubrooms and no sales will be allowed via the Club website.

**A** – No. A toucher must be marked with chalk by a member of the team that delivered the bowl or the marker as soon as it comes to rest.

**Q** – The skip of team "A" is standing on the mat getting annoyed, as the 3rd and skip of team "B" are discussing their last bowl that has just come to rest. Is the skip of team "A" justified?

**A** – As soon as each bowl comes to rest, possession of the rink will transfer to the opposing player or team after allowing time for marking a toucher as soon as it comes to rest.
