COACH'S CORNER: PETER BARRETT

The 5 "C" s of successful bowlers:

COMMITMENT: Commit to becoming the best bowler you can be. Commit to helping your teammates and club achieve success

CONFIDENCE: Have confidence in your own ability. Have the confidence to play the shot your skip asks for: - he/she has a better view of the head and is unlikely to call you on a shot he/she knows you can't play.

CONCENTRATION: Give every bowl absolute concentration – it will help with the Commitment and Confidence. Don't dwell on the previous bowl.... this one is the important one!

CONTROL: Have control over what you do; especially on the mat.... once the bowl leaves the hand, it's too late to change anything.

CONSISTENCY: Getting the first 4 C's right will give you the consistency to achieve success. <u>Every</u> bowler can deliver a world class bowl- the best bowlers simply do it more often!

Did you know that our Past President, and valued HVBC player and Greenkeeper, Ray Steer, won the coveted and prestigious Sunday Mail (football) Medal an incredible 4 times?

Ray started playing football at the age of 14 for Lameroo South Football Club. He was a rover come forward pocket player. As he got older, he developed as a very valuable centreman. He played in many inter-association games winning the Best on Ground on several occasions. Some of Ray's attributes were that he could read the game extremely well, he was quick around the ground, he had a very accurate kick and he was able to jump over the pack to take very good marks.

In 1963, Ray was asked to come down and train with South Adelaide under their coach, Neil Kerley. As he worked for other people, it made it difficult for him to get time off for travelling to Adelaide to train and play.

In 1972 we moved to Pinaroo and bought my parent's farm. During the first match of that season, Ray hurt his knee guite badly. He decided to retire from footy at age 30. His responsibilities with running the farm and the risk of further injury from playing, influenced his decision to withdraw from the game. (Kindly written by Avis Steer).


