UMPIRES CORNER

Q – What is the role of the MEASURER?

A – A Measurer must be accredited and undertakes identical training as all accredited National Umpires and as such is able to demonstrate their competency by carrying out the following required duties.

- Measure any disputed shot/s using suitable equipment, such as that described in Law 54



- Must decide whether the distance of the mat from the rear end and front ditches and the distance of the jack or bowl from the mat line are in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls or not
- Must decide whether a jack or bowl is in play or not.

A player can call for an umpire if they are not satisfied with the measurer’s decision.
