Pre-Season Tips

Tips for this Newsletter are in relation to your "aiming point" during your delivery:

- (1) Various methods of obtaining an aiming line can be correct. - you choose the method you are most comfortable with.
- (2) for consistent results ensure your feet are pointing along the desired aiming line.
- (3) Weather conditions will influence the correct aiming line.
- (4) Keep your eyes focused on your aiming point (with your peripheral vision on the jack).

and a recent question from a player.

Q. I'm having trouble controlling my weight on my shot what can I do?

A. The natural instinct immediately after delivering a bowl is to start thinking about where the bowl is likely to finish. If you want to improve weight control start by not thinking of the outcome and focus on primarily on remembering the "feel" of each and every delivery. It's all about feeling the speed, at the point of releasing the bowl. Its a mental thing. Don't grip the bowl too tightly, (except a drive shot). Just remember the "feel" and correct it with each subsequent delivery. And remember all this comes with Practice, practice, practice.

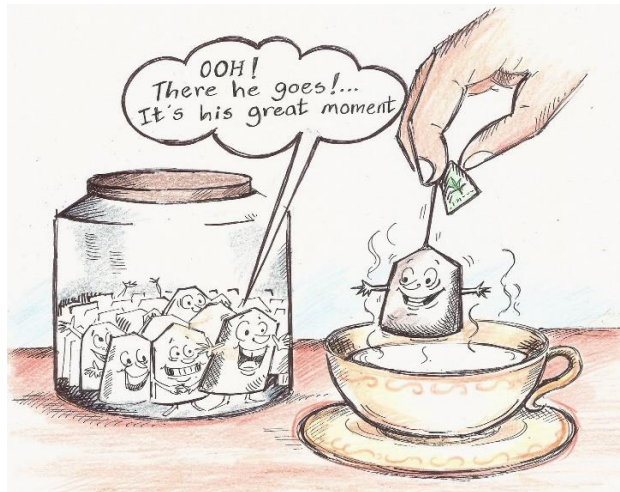
