TOILET RENOVATIONS

Have begun on Monday 3rd
June. We will do our best to
limit the inconvenience to all
members whilst the work is
being carried out. We are

\$110,000 from the State
Government, represented by
the Member of Davenport,
Erin Thompson, and a
significant contribution of
\$125,000 from the
Onkaparinga Council.

The first two to three weeks will be noisy and disruptive while the existing toilets are gutted, and the debris is removed.

Please note:

Indoor Bowls and Fitness classes are suspended until the toilets are finished.

Both days of Winter Social Bowls will continue as normal with some restrictions.

Please use the 2nd and 3rd doors to access the Clubrooms at all times. There are to be no bags placed between the gate and the 1st door at any time, so that the contractors have a clear passage in and out of the building.

There will be 3 Portaloos placed in the Bar Manager's parking spot. The Council will have these emptied every two weeks and we will clean and disinfect every week.

For the first few weeks there will be 2 skips placed where the Board members have car parks. This will reduce to 1 skip for.

There will be no other restrictions on the car park, so bins will be placed in the same positions as now, and there is room for all the delivery drivers to park where they do now.

We will not be employing our cleaner during the toilet upgrade, so don't be afraid to use the vacuum cleaner or broom when needed.

Raffles, tea/coffee/biscuits, still happening on social bowl days.
